



**Job Title:** Staff Biologist

### **Job Description**

Sequoia Ecological Consulting, Inc. is seeking as-needed and full-time mid-level biologists to perform compliance monitoring, biological surveys, and habitat assessments in California. These positions will support a variety of projects with flexible staffing requirements. Number of hours will be dependent on project needs. Travel is typically limited to within two hours of our Bay Area office location, with occasional exceptions.

### **Responsibilities**

Responsibilities will consist primarily of field work, with additional tasks that may include preparing technical reports, performing desktop analysis, and assisting with other deliverables. Examples of specific duties include nesting bird surveys, conducting habitat assessments and special-status plant and animal surveys, performing biological monitoring, and delivering environmental training to on-site staff. All work will be conducted under the guidance of Sequoia senior staff, and complete background information and instructions will be provided for each project and site.

### **Desired Education and Experience**

- Bachelor's or advanced degree in biological sciences, botany, wildlife, environmental sciences, or related field;
- Two years of experience performing field surveys and completing associated documentation;
- Experience with California flora and fauna: must have experience working on projects with California red-legged frog, California tiger salamander, burrowing owl, and other Northern California species;
- Excellent organizational and communication skills;
- Desire to learn from and collaborate with senior biologists; and
- Priority will be given to applicants with experience with nesting bird surveys, construction monitoring, and field experience with native plants and animals of California.
